Parent and Policy Information Kids Kollege 2017

The registration deadline for Kids Kollege 2017 is July 1, 2017. Registrations are first come, first serve. A student is not considered enrolled until the tuition, registration form and release form are received.

A maximum of 16 students will be accepted per class (Lego Robotics classes are limited to 12). A waiting list will be kept for classes that fill. A minimum enrollment of 8 students is required for a class to take place. If the minimum is not enrolled, the class will be canceled and tuition reimbursed or applied to another choice of classes. You will be contacted if a change needs to be made.

Parents are asked to deliver their children to their classrooms in the Prizery or Southern Virginia Higher Education Center or Innovation Center. Children will also need to be picked up in the classroom by parents. Classes will be from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, Monday-Friday. Please bring children no earlier than 8:50 and pick them up between 11:50 and noon.

Students should eat before they come to class since no food or beverages will be provided. Students need to bring non-perishable snack items from home to have during refreshment break. No food or drink will be available for purchase during class time.

*Please let us know if your child has any allergies.

Discipline Policy:

Each child is expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior necessary for learning. If a child disrupts a class and does not respond to correction, his/her parents or guardian will be contacted to pick up the child. The child will be allowed to return to class the following day. However, if the child continues the disruptive behavior, he/she will not be allowed to stay in the program and no tuition will be refunded.
